



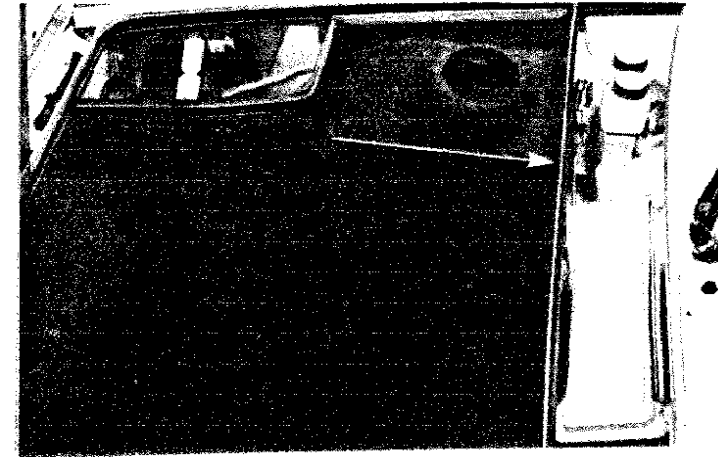
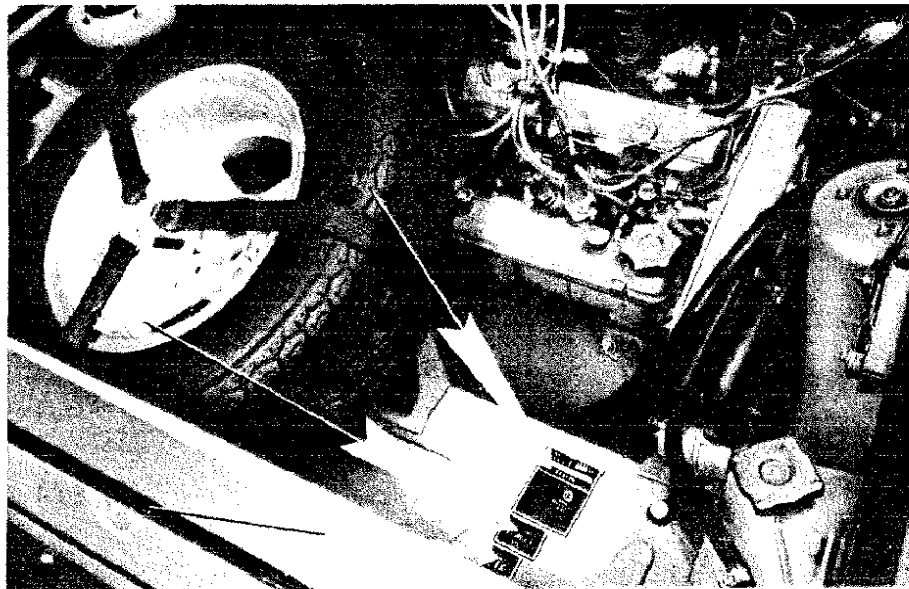

# DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF THE CATALOGUE AND FOR ORDERING SPARE PARTS

In this Catalogue there are listed and shown the spare parts supplied for the models specified.

The parts, listed in the tables which follow, are supplied up to the expiry date stated in the purchase contract and they are usually kept in stock by our Agents.

However some parts, bearing a specific indication, are supplied only till they, and the relevant model, are under current production.

They may even not be available at our Agents', though they are readily supplied following the procedure provided for the urgent orders.

The parts are listed in tables identified with progressive numbers and divided into Assemblies, Groups and Sub-groups as detailed in the **General Index**.

A **numerical Index** at the end of the Catalogue states, in progressive order, the ordering numbers of all the parts listed in the Catalogue, showing the table or the tables in which the part can be found.

For other directions, refer to the cardboard preceding such a numerical index.

In the first and last pages of each table, there is the picture of the parts listed identified with a reference number. In the intermediate pages, the parts are arranged in alphabetical order referred to the Italian description and also identified by progressive reference numbers corresponding to those in the picture.

Under the same reference number, there are listed the parts for right-hand or left-hand drive, the parts to be ordered together, the inner components and accessories of the part not shown in the figure.

Because of subsequent modifications, parts without reference number and not shown in the picture are sometimes added at the end of the list.

Each part is listed with ordering number (No. Ord.), car model from which the part originates (Origine), quantity per car (Q.), selling quantity (C.S.), application (Appl.) and description.

The selling quantity (C.S.) is the number of parts which are supplied by our Agents independently from the quantity ordered.

The car models specified in the last column are given only when the part is fitted to these models only and not to all. In some cases when a part fitted to one or more models is followed by another fitted to the remaining models, the latter bears the indication « p.a.t. » (for other types).

When the fitting of a part is limited by a serial number of application, or by other reasons, a reference is made in the column applications (Appl.), and an explanatory note in parentheses is stated at the end of the list.

The application serial numbers refer to the model or engine numbers. The parts fitted to right-hand or left-hand drive cars only are identified by the notes « rhd » or « lhd ». The words « right » and « left », « front » and « rear » mentioned in the description of the parts are always referred to the direction of motion of the car.

Some parts, though being supplied by different Manufacturers, are listed under a single ordering number and are supplied as available, because they are interchangeable; other parts however identified by different ordering numbers, bear the name of the Manufacturer included in the Italian description and must be ordered with the relevant number, as they are not interchangeable.

The catalogue is periodically brought up-to-date by issuing modified sheets which supersede the previous ones. In these sheets each page which has been modified bears at the bottom the date of the modification and an asterisk on the outer side of the page marks the items concerned by such modification.

To order the parts, please use the following forms fully filled-in:

- 88790362 to be used by the Italian Agents, if supplied by the Area Branches;
- 88790994 to be used by the Italian Agents, or Foreign Importers.

The orders must be addressed as follows:

- 1) Forwarded by the Italian Organization (Branches, Agents, Authorized Services, Body Repairers and Service Points):
  - to be sent to Agents and/or Area Branches by the Authorized Services, Body Repairers and Service Points;
  - to be sent to Area Branches by the Agents, if supplied by the Branch;
  - to be sent to SPARE PARTS DEPARTMENT - 193, Corso Peschiera - 10141 TORINO - Phone 33.31.1, Telex 23465 by the Agents, if directly supplied.

2) Forwarded by the Foreign Organization (Importers, Agents, Authorized Services and Correspondents):

- to be sent to Importers and Agents by the Authorized Services;
- to be sent to Importer by the Agents;
- to be sent to SPARE PARTS DEPARTMENT - 193, Corso Peschiera - 10141 TORINO. Phone 33.31.1- Telex 23465 by the Importers.

When ordering, always specify the ordering number (No. Ord.) and the car model from which the part originates (Origine), if shown on the Catalogue for each model. Orders bearing the description only will not be processed.

If no ordering number is specified on the Catalogue, please state, **beside the description**, the car model to which the part has to be fitted and also the chassis, or engine number and the ordering number of a similar part fitted to another model, obviously also state such model.

Any other information not exactly complying with the Spare Parts Catalogue is not only unnecessary but may raise confusion and delay the supply.

For this reason, parts wrongly ordered will not be taken back. In order to avoid mistakes, the Catalogue must be constantly kept up-to-date with all variants, either temporary or definitive, by inserting the new sheets which are printed from time to time and supplied to all the Organization.

The first page of the Catalogue lists all the variants carried out so far in progressive order.

It is advisable to check now and then that no variant is missing and that all have been duly inserted in the Catalogue by referring to the list at the beginning of the Catalogue.
